At that time you should be prepared to provide two (2) personal (non-relative) recommendations, evidence of community service, and a statement of financial need (if applicable).

Please consider that your essay is reflective of how you present yourself. Correct spelling and grammar, as well as content, will be of consideration.

EXHIBIT "A" FRIENDS OF THE ORO VALLEY PUBLIC LIBRARY SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The Friends of the Oro Valley Public Library Scholarships will range from \$1,000 to \$6,000 and are not renewable. Scholarships will be administered by a committee from the Friends of the Oro Valley Public Library in partnership with the Oro Valley Community Foundation.

The applications will be evaluated for a total score on each of the following criteria:

- 1. Complete application which includes:
 - a. Name of Applicant
 - b. Address of Applicant
 - c. Email and telephone
 - d. High School currently attending and expected graduation date
 - e. Unopened transcript of high school (completed) course grades up to the date of this application
 - f. All applications must be in receipt of the Friends of the Oro Valley Public Library Board of Directors Scholarship Nomination Committee no later than March 1st of the year in which the scholarship is to be awarded
- 2. A one-page typed essay describing future education and career goals and how the scholarship will help achieve these goals. Included in the essay must be a statement of willingness to mentor future recipients of the scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1) The applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the Oro Valley Public Library service area who plans on attending an accredited 2-year or 4-year college or university in the state of Arizona.
- 2) Students whose parents or grandparents are members of the Friends of the Oro Valley Public Library Board of Directors are not eligible to apply.
- 3) The application and support materials must be filled out completely to be considered.
